
Feminists of the world encourage women

choose a career,


obtain personal independence,

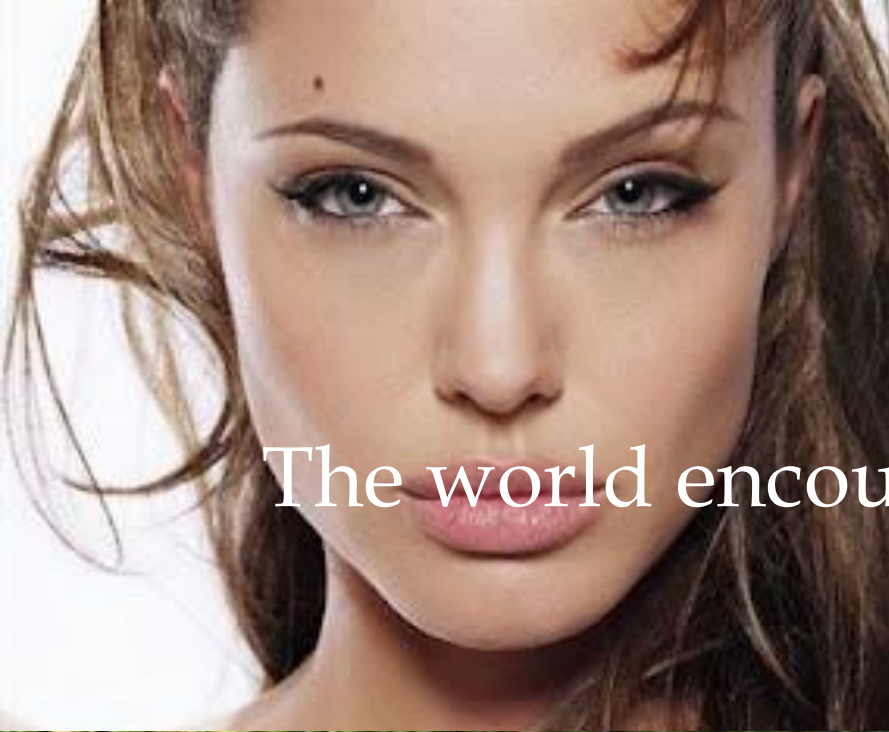



Is motherhood worth it?

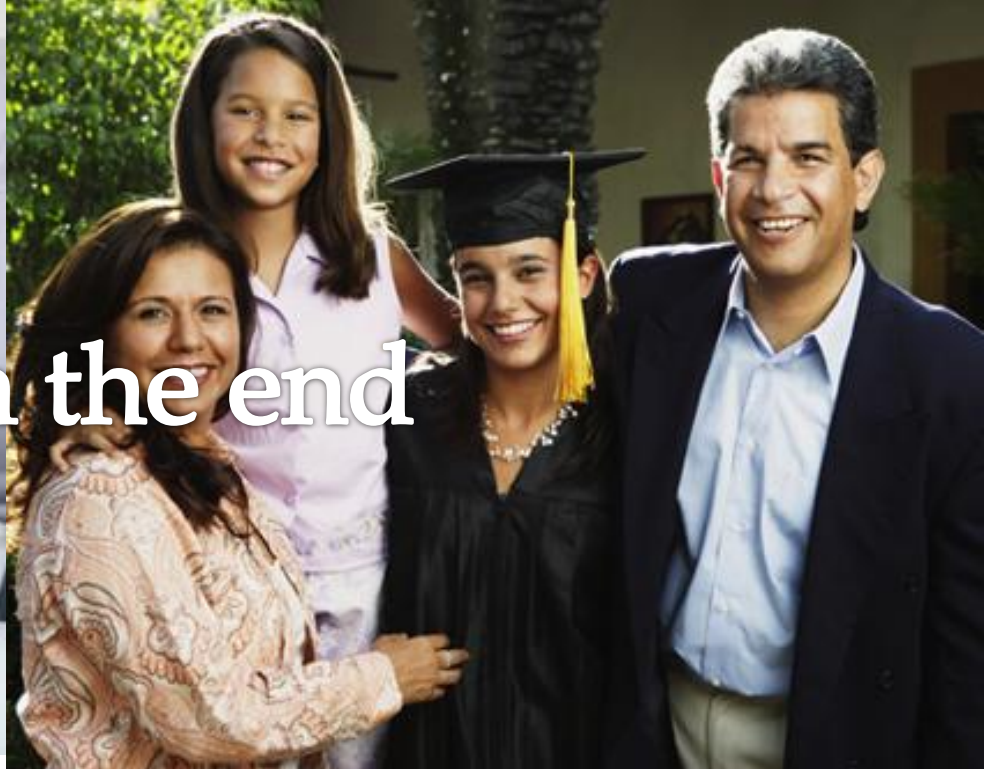
Mothers put up with a lot.
